### For God alone my soul waits in silence, from Him comes my salvation. Psalm 62:1

This year, after talking about it for a year or two, my daughter and her father-inlaw finally got me out hunting. I had watched them and so many others go hunting and always wondered a bit what it would be like, so this year was the year. So, after some initial lessons on safety and with a little practice, I headed out, tag in hand (in pocket actually) in borrowed hunting gear (and with an experienced hunter) for my first season. And, it didn't disappoint. I did enjoy it. I like being outdoors, enjoying the landscape while looking for deer, even when it was really cold on some days.

One of the things about hunting that made the biggest impression on me was the waiting, the waiting in silence, watching, alert to any movement that might signal the presence of a deer. And as I waited, in the silence, it reminded me a lot of what we do in the season of Advent. It always seems as if the church is out of touch with society with all of its Black Fridays, Cyber Mondays, festivals, get-togethers, parties, programs and all of the other hullabaloo that keep us running from one thing to the next. Advent is in direct contrast to that because it is about waiting, waiting in silence, not simply for the celebration of the birth of Christ, but looking for God's presence and movement in our lives and in our world. Silence is necessary so that we can focus on what we are looking for, so that we can hear God speak to us, without the noisy world drowning God out. And like with hunting, as we wait in silence we do so attentively, looking for those subtle signs that will help us to see where and how God comes to us. We wait in hope, we wait in trust, because we know that even if God's presence isn't readily apparent, God is there and we will see God.

And, while with hunting the promise might be unfulfilled (no I didn't get one this year) with God we know and trust that God is faithful to God's promises. God will come, even at times and in places we might least expect, like a manger in Bethlehem. A Blessed Advent and Christmas!

#### **Advent Meanings**

During Advent, which begins this year on December 3, many churches and families use wreaths to symbolize watchfulness and increasing joy as Christmas approaches.



Colors for the candles vary, with some traditions using blue (for hope or creation) and others preferring purple (for royalty, humility or penitence).

The four candles that each represent a week in Advent also signify hope, peace, joy and love. (The third candle is often pink.) In the center is the white Christ candle, representing Jesus as the light of the world. That candle is lit on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

The round, green Advent wreath has special meaning of its own. It symbolizes eternal life and the unending love of God, who sent his only Son to earth to die in our place.




